It's been almost 18 months since the relationship with our former pastor was severed. The following week, our Commonwealth's appropriate response to the COVID-19 pandemic led us to shut our church doors, bringing our valued time to worship together, and our personal lives, to a halt. These developments have impacted us in various ways. Some may feel we've processed our thoughts/feelings and have moved on. Some may have had conversations with other church family members. Others may have kept our feelings inside. However we may have chosen to handle (or not handle) what took place, we certainly know it was a painful time. We also know wounds and brokenness can only heal properly when they are dealt with in an honest, open, and candid way.

Pastor and First Lady Kilen and Cassandra Gray invites us all to gather at the church on Monday, August 30th, from 6:00 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. They will lead us in a time of honest, open engagement that we are calling "A Family Conversation". This is the time for us to come together and share our hearts. How did what took place last March impact us? What's the feeling that crept up inside us that we haven't shaken to this day? Our sole purpose on Monday, August 30th, is to lay to bare those lingering emotions.

We also have a Pastoral Search Committee laying groundwork for one of the most critical processes any congregation ever goes through. What we can't afford to do is bring the unfinished business of March 2020 to our next pastor. Rev. Gray is giving his all, through Wednesday Bible Study, Sunday morning sermons, and other conversations, to let us know God hears, feels, and understands our hurt; but we also have to do some healing work. As we're praying for our Pastoral Search Committee, let's also be in prayer for this matter of the heart at our Family Conversation on the 30th.

Please, let's understand and be on the same page: This is NOT a business meeting; there's no voting on anything. This is a heart meeting; it's only about our healing.




AS ALWAYS, THANK YOU FBCJ!
